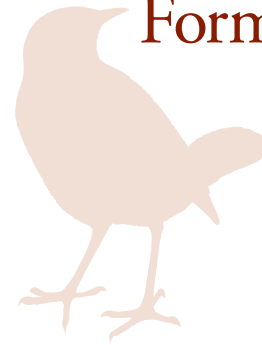


# Public Process Diagram and Explanation

## WHAT

### Step 1: Determining Values interviews & survey

The interview and survey step is the beginning of the planning process: it is the tool used to find out what the Values of the people in the town are. It is about "what" people value, not necessarily "how" to get there; how will be the subject of the final step. Values can be complimentary, or contradictory, what is important is that a clear measure of them be taken.

## WHY

### Step 2: A Common Vision vision statement workshop

The vision statement establishes the basic core values on which the town agrees. The vision establishes "why" the town is undertaking its policies, and which values it deems most important to protect. It forms the foundation for cooperation between different interests within the town.

## WHERE

### Step 3: Land Use Preferences marker - map game

The Marker Game helps refine the preferences people have for "where" things go. Coloring something one way or another does not guarantee that what you want goes there, or does not go there, whichever the case may be. The Marker Game helps identify clear areas of agreement and disagreement within the town.

## HOW

### Step 4: Tools Preferences scenarios workshop

Scenarios based on previous steps are presented to the towns people for their evaluation. The scenarios demonstrate various tools and approaches to achieving the town's Vision: the "how". Feedback on the scenarios determines which tools are best applied and where. Based on that feedback, specific recommendations are made for the general plan.
